**AUGUST 22 – 26, 2018**

Ireland was personally chosen by Pope Francis to host the World Meeting of Families in August 2018. The land from which so many missionaries set forth to bring the light of Christianity to every corner of the world, now invites families and individuals from every part of the world to come to Ireland to join us for these days, 22<sup>nd</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> August 2018.

The event has, at its heart, three main moments:

- **Three-Day Congress (22<sup>nd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> Aug)** – a joyful and reflective programme of workshops, talks and discussion. An engaging and exciting programme for young people as well as faith and fun activities for children.
- **Festival of Families (25<sup>th</sup> Aug)** – a special concert style event within a prayerful and joyful atmosphere, in which personal stories of faith will be shared by families representing the Continents of the world.
- **Solemn Eucharistic Celebration (26<sup>th</sup> Aug)** – this will gather thousands of people from Ireland and all over the world.
