In today's Gospel, Jesus makes it clear that if we want God to forgive us, we must be willing to forgive others. We always begin Mass by asking forgiveness for our sins. As we do so, we should also ask for the grace to forgive those who have sinned against us.

God is generous with his forgiveness. Let us open ourselves to God's forgiveness now.

Lord Jesus, you are slow to anger and rich in mercy.

Lord, have mercy.

As far as the east is from the west, so far do you remove our sins. Lord have mercy.

“Lord, remember not only people of good will but also people of ill will,
