All the saints were conscious of their sinfulness – and this forced them to rely more on the grace of God than on their own strength. While our own sinfulness humbles us, we must not let it get us down, or make us feel that we do not belong in the company of Jesus. He came to help us to overcome our sins, let us approach him with confidence and confess our sins.
