## 31<sup>st</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In the gospel of today's Mass we see the Lord's compassion towards a sinner – the tax collector Zacchaeus. The Lord extends his compassion to us too, as we now call to mind our sins.

Lord Jesus, you are kind and full of compassion. *Lord, have mercy.* You are slow to anger and abounding in love. *Christ, have mercy.* You support all who fall, and raise all who are bowed down. *Lord, have mercy.* 

It is only with the heart that we can repent rightly. Repentance must involve a change of heart. Anything less won't produce a new being. It will be like decapitating weeds while leaving their roots intact. But if we change our hearts, then we will change our lives too. After his encounter with Jesus, Zacchaeus' heart burst into life like a desert landscape after a rainfall. Fear can't produce a conversion of heart, only an encounter with love can. Zacchaeus' conversion was a conversion to goodness. All of us stand in daily need of such a conversion. We need to move from a closed heart to an open heart, from a heart of stone to a heart of flesh.

May the lilt of Irish laughter lighten every load, May the mist of Irish magic shorten every road, May you taste the sweetest pleasures that fortune ere bestowed, And may all your friends remember all the favours you are owed.
