In today's liturgy we hear again the lonely voice of John the Baptist : "Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight". It is not God's way that needs to be straightened out but our ways. God's way is straight. But our ways are not always straight. Let us reflect for a moment on the fact that we haven't always walked in God's way.

> Lord Jesus, you guide the humble in the right path. *Lord, have mercy.* You smooth the way for the upright. *Christ, have mercy.* You seek out and save the lost. *Lord, have mercy.*

The voice of John the Baptist was a lonely voice. There are many lonely voices in our world, coming not only from the prophets, but also from the victims of injustice and neglect.
