BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Today we celebrate the baptism of Jesus. In celebrating Jesus' baptism, we are celebrating our own baptism too, and renewing its grace within us. We know that we have not yet fully lived the life of a Christian. Let us call to mind our failures, and ask the Lord's forgiveness.

Lord Jesus, in baptism you made us children of the Father and heirs to eternal life.

Lord, have mercy.

In baptism you made us your disciples and witnesses for you before the world.

Christ, have mercy. In baptism you made us members of the Christian community, a

community dedicated to preaching and living the Gospel. Lord, have mercy.

To be baptised is to be christened, that is, to be made like Christ. But this doesn't happen automatically. We have to grow into it. Towards the end of his life a saint was asked if he was a Christian, and he replied, 'not yet'. Baptism is like the planting of a seed. It will take a lifetime for this seed to grow and ripen.
