# SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER The Commandment of Love

The gospel of today's Mass reminds us of the commandment Jesus left his disciples: "Love one another as I have loved you".

Love is the heart of the Gospel. Let us call to mind our failures to live by the commandment of love. The first love the Gospel talks about is God's love for us.
