*Lord Jesus, in baptism you made us children of the Father

before the world.*

Christ, have mercy.

*In baptism you made us members of the Christian
community, a community dedicated to preaching and living
the Gospel.*

Lord, have mercy.

To be baptised is to be christened,

that is, to be made like Christ.

But this does not happen automatically.

We have to grow into it.

*Towards the end of his life a saint was asked
if he was a Christian, and he replied, "not yet".*

Baptism is like the planting of a seed.

It will take a lifetime for the seed to grow and ripen.
